# Celebrating Communion

## Communion. *n*

*The act or an instance of sharing, as of thoughts or feelings.*

*Religious or spiritual fellowship.*

**T**oday we will share communion, we will celebrate the Lord's supper, we will remember the death and resurrection of Christ, just as He commanded us in the words "*do this in remembrance of Me*".

It's been said that in Jesus' hands, food took on new meaning. Every meal Jesus participated in that is recorded by a Gospel writer is in some way significant: a miracle or a teaching flows from the table into the heart and mind through the gullet of careful observers. He infuses the mundane with the sublime, and people push away from the tables newly and sometimes strangely filled. (*Dan Shmidt: Taken by Communion*)

But in an age of fast food, we need to understand that we can't enjoy the richness of the Lord's table if we

settle for a drive-thru approach. Simply ingesting the elements in a privatized fashion will leave us hungering for more.

In communion we are called to share more than bread and wine. We're called to share our hearts and minds ... or very lives with Christ, and with one another.

It's when we live in communion that we can "taste and see that the Lord is good" (Psalm 34:8).

It's when we share a common life that the Spirit of God can produce uncommon results. (Acts 2:42-47)

Gathering as the Lord's people to eat at His table reminds us that we do not live by bread alone.

This simple meal, shared in an authentic fashion, can transform us from factions of the faithful to a body of believers, from a collective to a community.

I pray that we will grow in communion with Christ and with one another daily.
